Seaquam Secondary School International Student Orientation

Welcome to Delta School District! Please take note of the information below. Depending on the day you arrive and your orientation schedule, please note that Steps 1 and 2 can be reversed!

Step 1: Come to **Delta School Board Office** for registration. Our address is 4585 Harvest Drive, Delta. We will welcome students for registration in the last week of August (August 28 to 31) between 9 am and 4:30 pm. **Please bring your passport, study permit and custodian declaration (parent) papers.** It is very important for students graduating in BC to **bring their original transcript from June 2023** in order for credits to be granted.

Step 2: Please go to <u>Seaquam Secondary School on Thursday, August 31 from 12:00 pm to 3:00 pm</u> for a new student orientation. You will meet your International Coordinator as well as other key school and International Program staff who will support you through your time in Delta. There will be a variety of orientation activities that will help you feel more at home in your new school. Your International Coordinator will discuss with you the course selection and course change procedures. There will also be a short English assessment. **Please bring a pen/pencil, paper, and folder for handouts.** Snacks will be provided.

Step 3: You are invited to a FREE new student sightseeing and welcome event on <u>Friday, September 1</u> <u>from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm</u>. Meeting location will be sent out in August and/or will be available at registration or your school orientation. This is a great opportunity to meet new friends and get to know other students from your school. Please bring your lunch and a water bottle or beverage and wear good walking shoes. You may also want to bring spending money.

Step 4: First day of school, <u>Tuesday, September 5</u> - Further information regarding time and duration will be sent out in August and/or will be available at registration or your school orientation.
