Applying for a visa

If you are applying for a Child Student visa or a Student visa you will need to send us the following documents before we issue a CAS for the visa application:

- 1. Bank documents showing the required funds to cover tuition fees and living costs, held for at least 28 days (except those from a country listed by the UKVI under the 'differential evidence requirement' or residential boarding students with full fees paid);
- 2. **A tuberculosis test** if you've lived in any of <u>these countries</u> for 6 months or more in the last 6 months;
- 3. **Proof of parental/legal guardian consent** if you're under 18.

Additionally, if you are relying on money held by your parent(s) or legal guardian you will also need to provide:

- 4. Letter from parent(s) or legal guardian with consent to use their funds;
- 5. **Copy of your birth certificate** showing the name of your parent(s) or legal guardian.
